

1997 FRUIT BELT ELECTRIC SERVICE FRANCHISE ORDINANCE

TOWNSHIP OF BAINBRIDGE

BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Ordinance No. 30

Adopted: August 4, 1997

Effective: For - 30 Years

An ordinance granting unto Fruit Belt Electric Cooperative, its successors and assigns, the right, power and franchise for a period of thirty (30) years from and after the adoption and approval hereof, to acquire, construct, operate and maintain in Bainbridge Township, Berrien County, the necessary facilities for the production, transmission, distribution and sale of electric energy for public and private use, and to use and occupy the highways, streets, alleys, and other public places of the township to set poles, string wires, lay pipes or conduits, and to transact a local electric business.

BE IT ORDAINED;

SECTION I

That Fruit Belt Electric Cooperative, its successors and assigns, be and it is hereby granted and vested with the right, power and franchise for a period of thirty (30) years from and after the adoption and approval hereof, as provided by law, to acquire, construct, maintain or operate in the Township of Bainbridge the necessary facilities for the production, transmission, distribution and sale of electric energy for public and private use, and to construct and maintain along, upon, across or under the highways, streets, alleys, and other public places of the township to set poles, string wires, lay pipes or conduit and other necessary fixtures and equipment for such purposes and to transact a local electric business.

SECTION II

This ordinance will take effect 10 days after the first publication of the ordinance.
